AquaBlanc Active O2 gives you clear, clean, gentle and safe water, without the odour and harshness associated with Chlorine.

Getting Started with AquaBlanc Active O2

Add a sachet of **AquaSPArkle Spa Fusion** to the spa water and run the pumps for 30-60 minutes – **with the COVER OPEN**.

DO NOT enter the spa until Chlorine levels are 5ppm or below and that pH is between 7.0-7.4 and TA (Total Alkalinity) is between 80-120ppm - (check with InstaTest 4+ Test Strips).

When Chlorine levels are 5ppm or below you can add AquaBlanc Active O2 following the guide below:

The Active O2 system is a dual component system requiring a weekly dose of Combination Liquid "A" and the addition of O2 Tablets before bathing.

Add the Combination Liquid "A" directly to the spa water whilst the pumps are running and put O2 tablets in the Floating Dispenser.

Combination Liquid "A" dosing – for spas up to 1,500 Lts.

Initial dose	Weekly dose

Using **Blue Horizons AquaBlanc 3 Way Test Strips** you are able to quickly and accurately assess water conditions and make necessary chemical adjustments.

Ideal AquaBlanc Active O2 Readings 5–10 ppm.

The Importance of Clean Filters

The AquaBlanc O2 system will breakdown bacteria but relies on good filtration to remove waste products. It is important that filters are rinse cleaned with a hose pipe each week and deep cleaned every 2 to 4 weeks with AquaSPArkle Instant Filter Cleaner, allow the filters to air dry naturally after cleaning, this kills bacteria and makes the filter more efficient.

Routine Shock Treatment

Every week or fortnight, depending on spa use, oxidise the water with **AquaSPArkle Spa Fusion**, this will break down contamination and non-filterable waste (body oils, fats, grease etc), helping to keep the water clean and clear. **FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS IN THE GETTING STARTED SECTION.**

Simple Tips

Foam Control: To reduce foam, take a quick soap-free shower prior to bathing in the spa.

Spa Water Change: Over time the water absorbs minerals and chemicals and makes it hard to maintain sanitation and water clarity. As a guide, you will need to **drain and refill your spa every 8-12 weeks**.

Filters: Keep a spare set of Filters to exchange when you deep clean the ones in use - Then you don't have to wait for them to air dry.

Scum Absorbers: Use Darlly Duck Scum Absorber sponges to reduce body oil and grease blocking the filter and creating a waterline ring, they also help to keep the water clearer for longer.
